### **Job Purpose:**

To support the efficient execution of the various types of survey projects undertaken by survey teams

- Maintenance of Survey equipment supervised
- Casual labourers effectively supervised
- Planting of Survey marks supervised

#### **Key Responsibility Areas:**

- Facilitates and records survey measurements
- Undertakes general care, storage and maintenance of survey equipment, while on field assignment
- Organizes and supervises the clearing of survey lines by casual labourers
- Assists in setting of temporary and permanent survey marks
- Provides general support to the survey team in the execution of field surveys

#### Other Responsibilities

Performs other related duties assigned from time to time by the Supervisor

# **Performance Indicators**

- Survey marks are checked to ensure that they are accurately embedded to facilitate the taking of survey measurements and to guide future surveys
- Equipment and instruments are checked for operational efficiency
- Casual labourers perform tasks to specification

• Checks done to ensure accuracy in measurement done by Field Assistant

- Good interpersonal and communication skills
- Knowledge of survey instruments and rudiments of survey
